## Our students break the stereotype of inner-city youth ...

Our student body is comprised of students who otherwise could not afford a collegepreparatory education. They come from 20 neighborhoods across Pittsburgh and surrounding communities. At TNA we respect racial. cultural and faith differences as we nurture, educate and support not only the students, but their families. At the core of our community is a desire to respond to a wide range of needs that affect our students.

Our student body is comprised of students who otherwise could not afford a college-preparatory education. They come from 20 neighborhoods across Pittsburgh and surrounding communities. At TNA we respect racial, cultural and faith

The Neighborhood Academy serves students ages 11-18 in grades 6 through 12. The 2019-2020 student body demographics include:



are African-American or biracial 80%

have a taxable family income of less than \$25,000 65%

live in a singlecaregiver household 48%

live in families with a history of drug and/ or alcohol abuse 46%

live in families with a history of domestic violence 31%

have experienced incarceration within their immediate family 92%

would otherwise be enrolled in a school categorized as 'lowperforming' by the PA Department of Education

acceptance rate to four-year colleges 300

number of colleges our students have been accepted to 70%

graduate college within 5 years 90%

return to the Pittsburgh region to enter the workforce



Our 2020 graduating class continued our 100% acceptance rate to four-year colleges and universities. In total, our graduates have been accepted to over 300 colleges. Even more importantly, 70% of our alumni have graduated from college within five years or are currently matriculated. When compared to the national average of only 11% of first-generation, low-income students graduating in six years or less, our results are all the more extraordinary. We stress the importance of not only going to college, but also excelling in and finishing college. Our students are given high expectations of scholastic performance, academic integrity and career preparation.

Our college graduates are now employed in growing fields throughout the Pittsburgh region. They include careers in finance, education, marketing, counseling, health care, and social work. Four alumnae have obtained their Master's degrees, with several others currently working to achieve this milestone.




